OWNER-OCCUPIED HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM

We are still accepting applications for the Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Community Development Block Grant.

- Eligible homeowners may receive assistance to make structural, mechanical, electrical, weatherization, and plumbing improvements to their homes.
- Housing units within the village limits of Sterling are eligible to participate in this program.
- There are certain eligibility requirements, including income, assets, and home ownership.
 - Financial assistance per household generally ranges from \$5,000-\$23,000 for each unit.
 - The maximum amount of assistance is \$24,999.
 - Sterling has awarded two projects and more are being reviewed and finalized.
 - Applications are available on the website or can be picked up at the village office at 140 Broadway Street.
